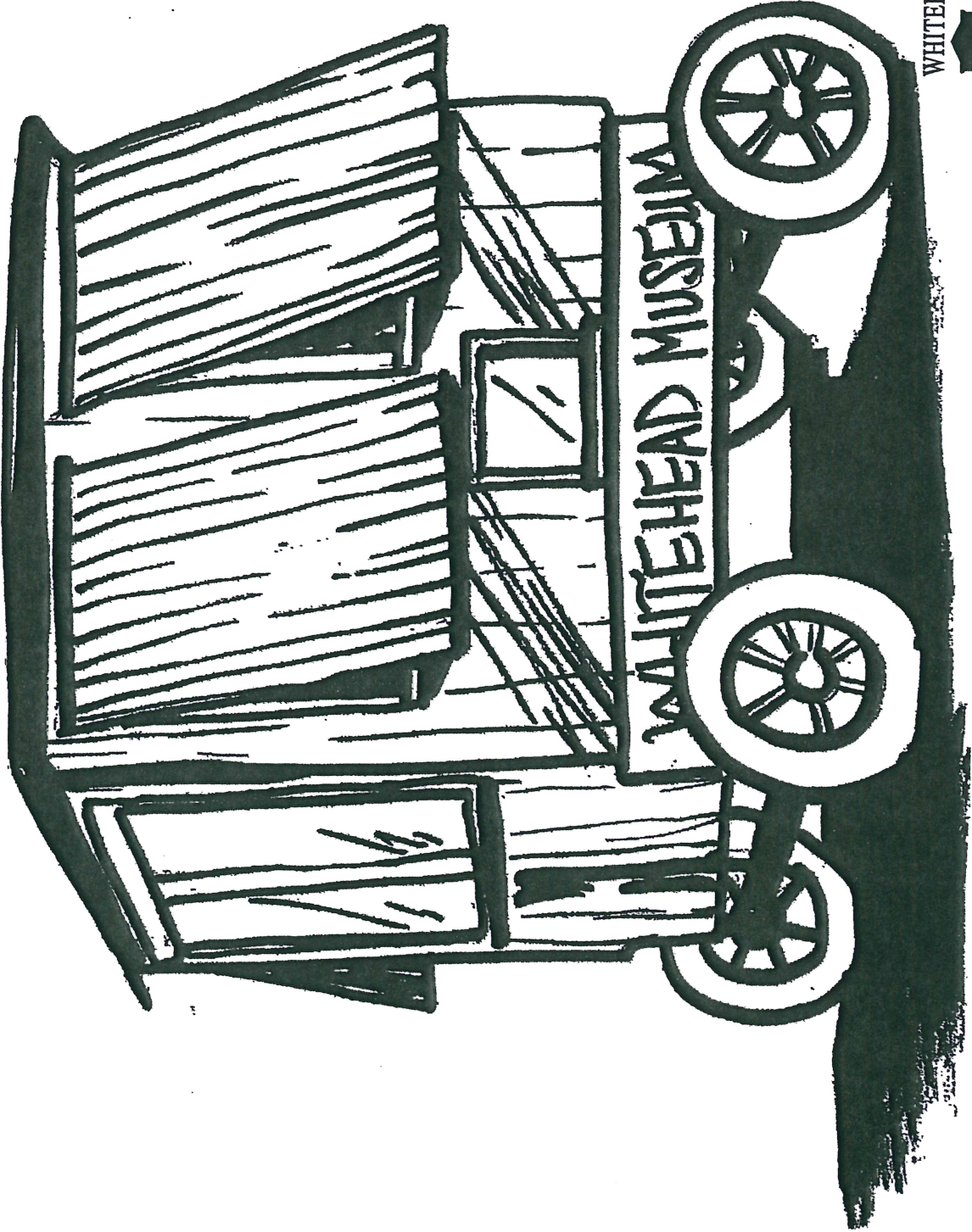
IMAGINE
